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Tim specializes in the creation of special purpose districts throughout Texas, particularly in the Houston and Dallas/Fort Worth areas. He has been involved in the development of thousands of acres of land for residential and commercial purposes, and the issuance of over \$15 billion of tax-exempt bonds for the financing of public infrastructure. In addition to his representation of special purpose districts, Tim represents land developers, land owners, and homebuilders.

Tim's area of practice includes matters related to the acquisition and development of real property, particularly the use of special purpose districts to finance development. Tim's representation has included the following: municipal utility districts, water control and improvement districts, levee improvement districts, municipal management districts, public improvement districts, tax increment reinvestment zones, and 380/381 agreements. Tim's practice includes representing his clients before various governmental entities, including: Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, and various cities, counties and regional service providers. Tim has also been involved in creating approximately 200 special districts through the Texas Legislature.

Lately, Tim's practice has focused on the creation of Public Improvement Districts ("PIDs") and the issuance of bonds secured by PID assessments and TIRZ Revenue.
